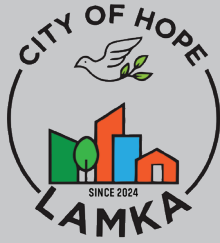


## PIONEERING INDUSTRY GROUP AWARD

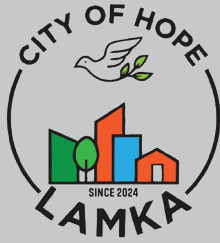

Khokon Roofing Industries was established in collaboration with Jupiter Company of Gujarat in 2023. It was inaugurated on the 22nd of June 2024. The industry began operational and started on full functional from 24th of June 2024. The word KHOKON was derived from a local dialect suggesting something of indigenous origin. The meaning 'KHO- Village, KON – Origin' thus 'KHOKON' means 'Originating from the Village.' The organization's mission and goal is to establish an industrial civilization in our own land to ensure rapid social development and economic stability, skill and capacity building, generate job opportunity and provide employment. The industrial activities include importing raw material from diverse locations and assembling product and goods with varying profiles. The industry major products include high-rib roofs, corrugated roofing, wall liners, crimping, ridges, and various types of flashing. Raw materials are in varying quality and variants. Variable hues and galvanize or galvalume that came in a basic roll sheet. The Khokon Roofing Industry currently engage seven operational machines and 15 (fifteen) employees and generated an impressive product of over 80 to 100 tons on a monthly basis. There are 14 (Fourteen) dealers in our district. The products are supplied to dealers and retailed to the general public based on their demands. As a startup industry with overwhelming positive response both ease of availability at the local market and for its quality Khokon have embarked on the future to increase production in the future. The future plans included upgrading additional machines and challenging Lamka individuals who are wealthy, knowledgeable, and empowered to establish more industries in variety of fields in order to transform our community into an industrial hub to achieve growth and development in financial, economic, and sustainable development. We have in this brief period made significant gains for the people. Before establishing the industry, the cost of roofing sheets were too steep but after Khokon began to operate and deliver products there was market gain for the common man as the prices is more affordable (Lower) yet with higher standard





product and quality. We also offer prices for persons like widows, women who have been displaced by current conflicts, religious people, and so on, depending on the case. Finally, KHOKON not only operates in the roofing business, but also in building construction and KHOKON Arena grass multi-sports facilities, with ambitions for further growth of our society.

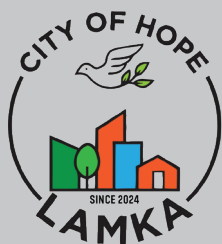

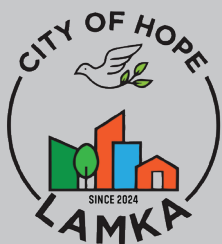

Bethesda School of Nursing, a pioneering institution in nursing education a project undertaken by the Independent Church of India. Brief History: Moulvaiphei Rural Health & Research Centre (MRH&RC) was founded in the year 1990 and registered in 1990 as a Non-Government Organization, Non-Political and Voluntary Organization under Manipur Societies Registration Act 1990 (Act No. 1 of 1990) bearing Society Registration No.247/SR 1990 Churachandpur dated the 5th June 1990. The Project is an undertaking of the Independent Church of India started with the purpose of uplifting the poor and needy people, who are living in the interior rural villages of Manipur state, North Eastern India where basic health care facilities are hardly available. The MRH&RC serve to provide health care facilities at their door steps and also trained and continue to train young people in nursing education so that they can earn their livelihoods. For the first five years, the project was funded by the Govt. of India in commemoration of the birth centenary of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar, the Architect of the Indian Constitution. But now, the project is solely run by the Church itself. Established on the 1st April 1995, the institute has a proud legacy of shaping compassionate and skilled nursing professionals. With over 1500 graduates, the pioneer Nursing alumni have made a profound impact in the healthcare sector, delivering exceptional care and service to communities in need. At Bethesda School of Nursing and now College remains committed to excellence in nursing education, empowering the next generation of healthcare leaders. Till date the Bethesda School of Nursing has produced 1500 General Nursing and Midwifery graduates. Currently, employing a dedicated staff Viz. 20 Teaching Staff and 18 Non-Teaching Staff a total of 38.

The Bethesda College of Nursing was started on the 1st of September 2016 offering BSc Nursing courses and 140 BSc Nurses (BSc N) graduated till date. Then in 1st February 2020 Post Basic Bachelor of Science (PB BSc N) in Nursing courses was started and 34 completed the course till date. Currently there are 148 GNM Nursing



Students, 133 BSc(N) Students and 32 PBSc (N). The nursing students actively participated in National Health Programs, School Health Programs and assist and help ASHA in the Community Home Visit programs. The students also actively participated in health camps organized by different organizations. The institution excels in grooming and shaping the lives of many young girls to become professional nurses, working in and outside the state. Graduates from Bethesda have been employed abroad too making a shining example and the best of nursing care locally, nationally and internationally. Bethesda Nursing institute looks into the future of nursing education by strategic objectives and enhances the quality of education, innovations, research, promoting professional developments. It also envisioned state of the art facilities, technological integration and a make a comprehensive resource center for nursing research.

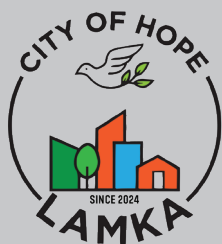


## HEALTHTECH EXCELLENCE AWARD

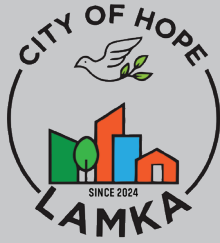


## WOMEN EMPOWERMENT TRAILBLAZER AWARD

RWUS is a non-profit women organization founded in 1990. Started in Lamka with an aim to uplift women from marginalized section of the Society. With humble beginning from voluntary donations but today plays a resource center for individuals and groups in the region. With a vision of people's empowerment for justice, peace and development focus on indigenous women. Its mission is to empower people through capacity building, awareness raising, workshops, trainings, consultations, campaign, advocacy, lobby work, networking and alliance building and giving material support to the poorest. The main areas of intervention are: 1. Women Leadership and governance. 2. Food and Livelihood Security. 3. Environment and natural resources. 4. Micro Financing, the current projects of RWUS are- Organic spice clusters – working with 500 farmers. Supporting 500 women artisans, traditional weavers, vegetable vendors, small business, life skills training, tailoring and beautician for school dropout girls and IDPs, installation of community food bank and see bank, SHG Support. Women and Environment: To protect, promote, manage natural resources through knowledge building, collaboration with local government, environment campaign. Strengthening local governance through gender, health and education. Knowledge building, youth engagement, networking with local governments departments, initiation of community resource Centre. RWUS work directly with the local community in Lamka, Pherzawl district, and with network with other women organization in four North East states – Manipur, Nagaland, Assam and Mizoram. RWUS also engage with women organization nationally, regionally and international platforms.

## DISTINGUISHED HUMANITARIAN SERVICE AWARD

The Kuki Khanglai Lompi (KKL) literally Kuki Youth Association, is a voluntary philanthropic organization synonymous with the working ideology of International Red Cross Society. The organization was founded by Pu Onkholun Haokip in 1988. Which later on came to be known as Kuki Khanglai Lompi-General Headquarters (KKL-GHQ). The founder and its first Executive Committee registered KKL under registration no. 142/RR/19ii of the Manipur Co-Operative Societies Act 1976. The organization was founded in line with the age-old Kuki traditional institution called LAWMPI. KKL has its headquarters at IB Road, Churachandpur, Manipur and one regional headquarters at Jiribam, Manipur. There are about twenty branches that spread across Manipur and Assam. The organization is headed by its president with a term of 3 years. Prior to the current ethnic clash in Manipur, KKL has taken an active role in providing relief to victims of accidents, floods, landslides, pandemics, ethnic conflict victims, and many more, wherein special mention may be made of the following events.

1. Jomol Landslide and Churachandpur-Chandel Flood of 2015. On 28th July, 2015, due to heavy rain for two weeks, the entire Jomol Village in Chandel District was washed to the underneath river. The incident left 9 persons dead and hundreds homeless. Apart from the landslide in the hill, the Imphal River submerged more than 36 villages on both sides of its banks in Churachandpur District and Chandel District for 2 weeks. KKL organized crowdfunding and calls for public contributions and provided clothing, rations, and makeshift roofing to the victims.
2. Henglep Dengue Pandemic 2017: In August 2017, news of an acute attack of dengue in the Henglep area reached the KKL-GHQ office. On further inquiry, it was learned that 4 villages within Henglep Sub-Division, namely Henglep, Ainujang, Vongjang, and Najang, were hit by a possible massive outbreak of dengue. All the sick persons were transported to Churachandpur District

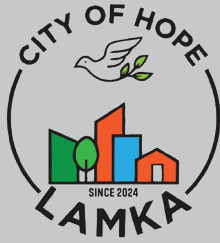




Hospital by Shaktimans and were given medication, food, and lodging by KKL at District Youth Hostel for 2 months.

3. During the COVID-19 pandemic, KKL donated 5 cylinders of oxygen to the district administration, manned 4 quarantine centers, and helped the district administration in the transportation of the mainland returnee to the district.
4. The ongoing ethnic clash in Manipur. Right from the night of 3rd May, 2023, KKL began to busy itself in giving food and lodging to IDPs from the Torbung-Kangvai area. As the gravity of the clash intensified, the number of IDPs increased unmanageably. Presently there are 53 relief centers where more than 9000 IDPs are housed. All these IDPs are individuals who have lost all their belongings, like houses, movable and immovable assets, and directly depend on the meager quantities of rations, essential items, clothing supplied by the government, and medicine supplied by KKL. Relief Centre under KKL: 64 Relief Centres (50 present).

The current number of Inmates: 11234. Female -5762 Male- 5472, Pregnant Women- 62, 60 years above- 700. KKL will strive even more determined and tirelessly to bring relief and the welfare of the community and give hope and healing.

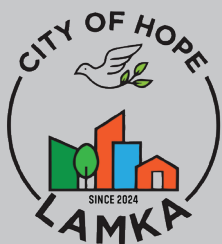

Young Mizo Association (YMA), established in 1935, is a non-political, voluntary organization with its Headquarter in Aizawl, YMA has 5 sub-headquarters, 47 groups and 805 branches, which covers all of Mizoram and some parts of Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Nagaland and Tripura. Young Mizo Association (Lamka Branch) was set up in 1956. It has over 1,200 active members. YMA Lamka Branch as other active branches main activity is philanthropic and voluntary services to the community especially to those in need and in times of suffering and distress. Where most of the voluntary humanitarian work are shouldered by the members of the association to bring relief to sufferings.

YMA enduring selfless humanitarian services in the past 19th months and continuing each day since 3rd May 2024 addressing the mayhem and suffering brought out by the ethnic violence in Manipur, which broke out on May 3, 2023, displaced around 60,000 people – a majority of them tribals. Churachandpur, being the largest tribal-dominated town in the state, received the bulk of those fleeing the violence. YMA Lamka Branch has played a pivotal humanitarian role in philanthropic activities related to displaced people in the state from the beginning of the ethnic conflict in the first week of May 2023. During the first couple of months of the conflict, food aid and necessary items, including were provided thousands of displaced people through donations made by individuals and organizations, especially from the people of neighboring Mizoram. All the donated food and clothes for displaced tribals were stored in YMA Lamka Branch's multipurpose hall from June, 2023. Distribution of donated items to relief centers started from July, 2023. YMA Lamka Branch members were on volunteer duty day and night to guard the hall and issue supplies. As the conflict continued, buffer zones were set and hundreds of villagers along the buffer lines were provided essential food and rations. The organization apart from providing security on a 24



hours basis at the YMA warehouse gathered food items and transport them to the frontliner and villages along the buffer zones once every week for the last 19th months. The delivery of these food items typically took an entire day as each as there were multiple drop-in centers along the border in the frontlines. Till date the YMA hall continues to be the warehouse for food and essential items for the frontlines.

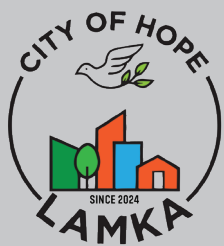


## LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT IN HIV CARE AWARD

Society for HIVAIDS and Lifeline Operation in Manipur is a non-governmental organization established in 1995 in Lamka. The main objectives of SHALOM is in the HIV Prevention, care for People living with HIVAIDS and mitigation of the socio economic impact of HIVAIDS epidemic on individuals, families and communities. The organization has five components – Harm reduction, care and support, advocacy, capacity building and community systems strengthening. The main focus of its activities are high risk groups consisting of Injecting drug users (IDUs), Female Sex Workers (FSW), and Men who have Sex with Men (MSM) as well as the community of people living with HIV (PLHIV). SHALOM currently implement four projects. 1. Targeted Intervention 2. Core Components Project. 3. Vihaan Project. 4. Project Sashkt and 5. Project Rapha. And works in partner with YRG CARE in two projects – STOP C and Project Accelerate OVC Component. The overall achievement and impact of SHALOM till today is providing care and support services to 2795 PLHIVs, 1215 IDUS, 361 FSW and 233 MSM. The Services for PLHIV included medical, nutritional, travel and psycho-social support. High Risk Groups (HRGs) are provided with Syringes and needles, condoms, STI Treatment, Overdose response, Opioid Substitution Treatment (OST) and Hepatitis treatment. Harm Reduction and care and support efforts have greatly decreased HIV incidence and prevalence among IDUs and FSWs and with MSM and female IDUs it is showing gradual decline.

The concept of Happiness Home began in 2007 when Bro. Rama was visiting someone in the local hospital in Churachandpur. There he learned of a young mother and child with HIV/AIDS from Assam. Who were being released from Hospital but had nowhere to stay. She needed to remain in the area in order to have access to medical treatment to stay alive. Bro. Rama offered the lady and her child a tiny mud hut to live in. Word spread at the hospital that Bro. Rama was willing to shelter people with HIV/AIDS so people started going to him for help. He soon needed a bigger place. Bro. Rama knew the perfect place but the owner would not sell the property to him. Bro. Rama prayed, and three years later, the man agreed to sell the property to him. Not only did the man sell his property to Bro. Rama even the neighbor agreed to sell his too. Thus, Happiness Home began. In 2009, Agape School was started within Happiness Home to provide education to the children since they could not attend the local schools due to some of them being infected with HIV/AIDS. The school is run by local volunteers who teach the children. They study many subjects including geography, music, science, history, math and English. The children are placed in a class according to their skill level where they learned at their own pace and then advance to the next class level once they have mastered their current class level. The classes are small and the children are often given one-on-one attention throughout the day. Currently, Happiness Home has 72 members 64 are students with new people entering the Home on a regular basis.

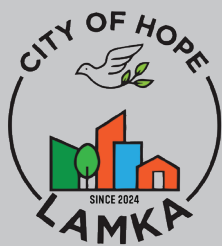


## PLASTIC FREE PIONEER AWARD
